The following is the budget and programme for the above trip.

1.	Transport from Kuala Lumpur to Kahang (on the 14 th) and back (on the 16 th)	3, 000.00
3.	Transport from Kahang to kampong Peta (14 th) and back (16 th) by four wheel drive (4x4). Food, lodging, jungle trekking activities, dugout boat ride, other activities and guide (inclusive of lunch on the 14 th and lunch and dinner on the 16 th)	3, 450.00
3.	Total expenses for 3 days and 2 nights as a package for 10 persons, five persons to a 4x4 vehicle excluding driver	6, 450.00

- Note:
- (i) The bus can take up to 30 people.
 - (ii) For every additional person after the package of 10 persons, the cost per person is as follows, due to the cost of 4x4 transport. The maximum passenger per 4x4 is 5 persons.
 - (iii) Taniguchi Sensei and Shimizu Sensei can share a chalet with 3 rooms. The others can stay in a dormitory. If a 2-bed chalet with private bathroom is required, there is an additional RM 160 charge for the 2 nights.
