



Itinerary of 60th Seminar Study Tour in Bangkok/Chiang Mai

♣ Day-By-Day Itinerary ♣

Day 1 Friday 10 March
Depart JAPAN/Bangkok, Thailand

Day 2 Saturday 11 March
Bangkok/ Phranakhon Rajabhat University(PRU)

Travel to the Grand Palace (Wat Phra Kaew), you'll enjoy lunch at MK restaurant. Setting the teleconference system at Environmental Education Center. You'll enjoy the welcome dinner at Chai Thale Junpen Restaurant.

Day 3 Friday 12 March
PRU

Join graduate classes at Environmental Education Center, PRU. The class (I): *Environmental Education Activity: Linked Thinking* instructed by Dr. Joan Webb, environmental education consultant in Australia from 9:00 am-14:30 pm. From 15:00 pm -18:00 pm, the class (II): *International Exchange of Environmental Education between Konan University and Other University in Foreign Countries* and the class (III): *Mind Environment through Sand-play World for Environmental Education*, instructed by Prof. Fumiaki TANIGUCHI, Konan University, Japan. You'll enjoy dinner cruise at Ayutthaya River.

Day 4 Saturday 13 March
Chiang Mai

Fly to Chiang Mai, travel to the Ban Tawai village, where you'll enjoy shopping – traditional industrial arts and furniture. During a tour of Chiang Mai, see the Cotton Factory (Pa Da Foundation in Chom Thong), Pa-Da Cotton Textile Museum, Wat Pharthat Sri. You'll stay at Doi Inthanon National Park for two days.

Day 5 Sunday 14 March
Chiang Mai

A morning tour begins at Doi Inthanon National Park through the Doi Angka nature trail, and an afternoon tour begins through the Guin Mae Pan nature trail, where you'll see the Royal Agricultural Station Angkhang, established in February 1979 as the royal initiative projects, where located the northern most provinces of Chiang Mai and Chiang Rai. The tour takes approximately one hour and thirty minutes. Then, you'll also see the farm of the rainbow trout including royal initiative projects.

Day 6 Monday 15 March

Chiang Mai

Depart the Doi Inthanon National Park. You'll see the Thai Elephant Conservation Center in Lam Pang, where is the elephant hospital and rehabilitation center and is the work of the dedicated forestry officials and civilians, under royal patronage.

An additional afternoon tour, focusing on important sites that may have been missing during your earlier visit, offers ample time to enjoy the sheer beautiful and traditional site; umbrella factory, Doi Ishuank in Sam Kamphaeng, and so on. Then savor a Thai dinner and stay at the Empress Hotel Chiang Mai. You'll enjoy shopping at night bazaar.

Day 7 Tuesday 16 March

Return to Bangkok/PRU

Depart Chiang Mai and return to Bangkok in the morning.

After lunch, in-class exercise of activities for study tour; student discussion on field experience and the lecture (IV): *International Exchange and International Comprehension* from 16:00 pm – 19:30 pm at the Environmental Education Center.

Day 8 Wednesday 17 March

Koh Kred

An additional morning tour to Koh Kred in Nontha Buri.

From afternoon to evening, you'll participate in an on-line test of teleconference between PRU and Konan University.

Day 9 Thursday 18 March

Phat Buri/Pran Buri Forest

Travel to Phat Buri en route to Pran Buri Forest. Stop briefly at the palm factory, salt field in Phat Buri, and you'll stay one night at Pran Buri Forest. In the evening, you'll enjoy swimming in Pran Buri National Park Beach.

Day 10 Friday 19 March

Bangkok/Return to Japan

During your stay, enjoy bird watching, walk and cruise the mangrove forest.

There is time to rest at the Grand View Hotel (PRU) before tonight's farewell dinner.

Transfer to the Dong Muang Airport for your return flight to Japan in the midnight.
